to the Department of the Czech Literary Bibliography.

Job description:

- Processing biographical data for the needs of the databases of the Czech Literary Bibliography (CLB);
- creating bibliographical records in the Aleph library system;
- researching activities (digital resources and libraries), editing the databases;
- participation in the research activities of the CLB;
- participation in a research project focused on the processing of the special category of periodicals (almanacs, calendars, and yearbooks).

Requirements:

- Required education: university degree (minimum completed Bachelor's degree), ideally in Czech language and literature, history, archival science, librarianship or related fields, or full secondary education with relevant experience in a similar position;
- accuracy, diligence, conscientiousness.

- knowledge of German at a level of the written text comprehension;
