#### Job description:

- Data control and analysis for the Czech Literary Bibliography Research Infrastructure;
- preparation and automatised enrichment of datasets for further processing;
- conversion and retroconversion of data suitable for inclusion in the CLB databases;
- related data research in bibliographical and literary studies data (if interested);
- participation in developing the CLB software tools (if interested).

#### **Requirements:**

- Interest in work with databases, data-driven research or digital humanities;
- basic knowledge of the language Python, possibly R;
- experience of working with spreadsheets (MS Excel, Google Sheets, etc.);
- analytical and system thinking;
- diligence, conscientiousness, independence, teamwork skills;
